<p>Food for five people for a day.</p> <p>17 children's books for families in a literacy program.</p> <p>Six hours of relief for family members that have become primary caregivers for a family member with an illness or disability</p> <p>Five youth scouting memberships for girls.</p> <p>Education for 40 renters and landlords about their rights under the law.</p> <p>Protein-rich tuna fish and peanut butter to supplements 52 hungry families' (one each week) grocery bags.</p> <p>Two weeks of transportation to and from work for a victim of abuse or sexual assault while staying at a safe house.</p> <p>Legal assistance to 5 individuals in a legal clinic.</p> <p>26 meals for people requiring special dietary needs.</p> <p>\$52 a year</p>	<p>Two months of meals for a homebound person.</p> <p>Five wigs for children with cancer undergoing chemotherapy.</p> <p>A year of scouting for one boy.</p> <p>30 hours' local transportation fare.</p> <p>Two nights of shelter for a troubled or neglected youth.</p> <p>After school care (food, health, recreation, and homework help) for one child for a year.</p> <p>Clothing, shoes and a winter coat for one individual who has lost everything in a home fire.</p> <p>Temporary shelter for a family of four for three nights following a disaster, or shelter for 10 people for one night.</p> <p>Three or four bus tokens a week for 162 homeless people to get to job interviews or doctor appointments.</p> <p>Three bowling trips for seniors.</p> <p>An airline ticket to California or theme park tickets for a family of four with a critically ill child.</p> <p>Gas or power service for an elderly or disabled person who has been threatened with a termination notice.</p> <p>Five hours of employment counseling, resume preparation, and job interview coaching for legal refugees.</p> <p>Three months of help with housekeeping, daily hygiene, and chores for an individual with disabilities or elderly person.</p> <p>Two weeks of developmental preschool for a child with developmental needs.</p> <p>Access to public structures for people with disabilities.</p> <p>12 hours of a parenting education class for two parents.</p> <p>An initial prenatal visit for a pregnant teen.</p> <p>11 Braille books for a pre-school class for visually impaired children.</p> <p>Respite care provided for a child with a severe or multiple disabilities.</p> <p>\$260 a year</p>	<p>Two days of care for a terminally ill individual.</p> <p>Baby formula for 52 low-income infants (one each week).</p> <p>A full year of scouting for two girls.</p> <p>Five and a half weeks of work training.</p> <p>One month of preschool for a child at risk of falling through the cracks.</p> <p>Funding for daily radio legislative updates, during the legislative session and monthly for interim committees.</p> <p>Lightweight wheelchair for a person who is physically challenged.</p> <p>Sponsors a panel discussion at a state humanities nook festival.</p> <p>Allows five people being treated for mental illness to attend recovery classes that provide education, peer support, and healing strategies.</p> <p>Helps to construct a tower with associated transmitting equipment to broadcast live City Council meetings and other important public information.</p> <p>\$520 a year</p>
